## DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE (D&P) FALL ACTION

The theme of this year's Fall Action is Create Hope: Reaping our Rights.

D and P are focusing on the rights of peasant and smallfarmer communities in the Global South whose rights to land, water, seeds, food sovereignty and a clean environment are threatened by corporate interests, land grabbing, resource theft and climate change.

Later this month, parishioners will be asked to sign a petition which will be forwarded to the Canadian government, asking that no Canadian company be allowed to violate the human and environmental rights of these rural communities.


