

Dear Parishioners,

The gospel of St. John proclaimed on Christmas Day invites us to reflect on words of joy, wonder, and mystery: "...the Word became flesh and lived among us..." (Jn.1:14).

Indeed, what a mystery! For our faith teaches us that the Second

Person of the Holy Trinity, who was the Divine and Eternal Word, existed from eternity with the Father and the Holy Spirit as a Divine Communion of Persons – all of whom shared the same divine essence in spiritual form.
