Since the invasion of Ukraine began in February 2022, Prince George Share Hope Refugee Support Society has helped to settle 374 displaced Ukrainians within 147 families across our diocese. Thank you to all who have opened their homes, taught English, found jobs, donated money, furniture and clothing, and shared time with all our families.

There are two new families arriving February, 16. They currently live close to the Russian occupied territory near Zaporizhia which is making their situation there untenable.

We are approaching the third-year anniversary since declaration of the war and there is no longer any government support. Share Hope depends entirely on donations to assist those who have come to us.

We have a responsibility to help those who still need assistance in finding jobs to make enough money to cover their costs, (rent, food, etc.). Emotional support is also important, the trauma they have suffered and continue to suffer from leaving their homes and loved ones behind is vast. It really takes courage and tenacity to learn a new language and customs.

We not only need more financial assistance, but we also need more volunteer members.

We are pleading for financial assistance to be able continue our efforts.
