On this first day of Lent, we

receive ashes on our foreheads in the form of a cross, with the words "Repent and believe in the gospel". The cross of ashes is a sign of our faith and a reminder of repentance for our sins.

With these ashes, we recall our origins from the earth, as well as how our bodies shall return one day to the same form (as indicated by the dictum "Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return").

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of Fasting and Abstinence in the Church. Fasting, for all those who are 18 to 59 years of age, and in reasonable health, and abstinence from meat for those 14 and older. Parents and educators are the greatest influence in modelling these practices to children to help them understand their importance.

Fasting is one of the three pillars of Lent, along with prayer and almsgiving. It is a practice of self-discipline with a focus on penance intended to strengthen our faith and serve as a witness of our faith. It allows us to share in the suffering of those who are hungry.
