Reflection for the 2nd Sunday of Lent

LENT Pray + Fast + Give Reflecting on the themes of the 2nd Sunday in Lent, consider the following questions to deepen your understanding and application of these

passages in your life:

- Faith in Testing Times: Reflect on a moment in your life when your faith was tested. How did you respond? Can you see any parallels between your experience and Abraham's willingness to trust God, even when asked to make a significant sacrifice?
- Listening to God's Voice: "Here I am" signifies a readiness to listen and respond to God. How can you cultivate openness and readiness to God's call in your life? Are there changes you can make to better hear and respond to God's voice?
- Understanding Sacrifice: The concept of sacrifice in these readings is profound, from Abraham's near-sacrifice of Isaac to the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus. In what ways are you called to make sacrifices, and how do these sacrifices contribute to your growth in faith?
- The Transfiguration and Transformation: The Transfiguration of Jesus is a moment of divine revelation and affirmation. How does this event challenge you to transform your understanding of suffering, glory, and the purpose of your life in Christ? How can you more fully embrace the journey from suffering to glory in your own life?

CCCB Sends Letters to the Hon. Pierre Poilievre and Hon. Mark Holland Regarding Charitable Status and MAiD

On March 10, 2025, the CCCB sent two letters to the federal government. The first, addressed to the Hon. Pierre Poilievre, Conservative Party Leader and Leader of the Official Opposition, was regarding concerns about proposals made by the federal Standing Committee on Finance to change eligibility criteria for charitable status. Such changes would make it so that organizations which support the advancement of religion or pro-life initiatives will no longer be eligible for charitable status.

The second letter, addressed to the Hon. Mark Holland, Minister of Health, was regarding a recently-concluded "national consultation" on expanding Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) in view of introducing advance requests.
